HOW TO CLEAN AN FRP DOOR & FRAME

The following are suggestions for cleaning Corrim Fiberglass doors and frames:

Start out by using a mild detergent like dish washing soap and warm water. Rinse the area with warm water. If this does not remove the dirt try a mild citrus cleaner and warm water, again rinse when finished. Always use a soft cloth and not paper towel. A mild vinegar and water solution or a mild isopropyl alcohol and water solution may work well also. Aggressive cleaners like mineral spirits or solvents will break down the finish surface and change the appearance of the surface by making it shinny. Matte finish or low sheen doors and frames are susceptible to becoming shinny with too much rubbing. The more rubbing that is done, the shinier the surface will end up when the cleaning process is finished. If the doors are Gel Coated, we have a surfacing wax on the doors for the gel curing process. Hard rubbing will act like car wax and make the doors shinny.
