

CORRIM COMPANY TIMELINE

1982:

Corrim Company (Corrim) was founded in Conroe Texas.

1985:

Corrim was acquired by Fenestra Corporation, a wood door, steel and stainless steel door and frame manufacturer.

1993:

Corrim fiberglass door and frame operations were moved from Conroe, Texas to Oshkosh, Wisconsin.

1995:

Fenestra Corporation separated the companies and Corrim was acquired by a private investor from the Chicago area who moved to Oshkosh to manage the operations.

1996:

Corrim single and pair doors and frames passed the 120 MPH (positive and negative) static wind load tests to meet the Florida Building Code.

2005:

Corrim again successfully passed the 165 MPH positive, negative, static, cyclic and impact tests to exceed the Florida Building Code requirements.

2010:

Corrim moved from a 15000 square foot facility to a 35000 square foot energy efficient facility, incorporating wind turbines for renewable energy generation and geothermal climate control.

2015:

Corrim added 360 photovoltaic panels to add renewable energy to our facilities electrical grid.

DECEMBER 2018:

Corrim was purchased by two employees.

JANUARY 2019:

The new owners of Corrim, the world's Premier Fiberglass Door and Frame company that is committed to Made In America quality and headquartered in Oshkosh, WI. were introduced to the company employees.
